4. How would you summarise the qualities that the apostle has shown?
5. What does God promised us as those who are in Christ? What can we expect life to be like?

6. How did you feel when you read the apostles description of his life? Did you find it attractive, astonishing, scary... or something else?
7. How do you feel about the challenge to live life following Jesus in the same way that the apostle followed him?
8. Which aspect of Paul's description would you find most challenging personally, and why?
9. When we do not respond to the Lord's prompting, we are in danger of receiving gods grace in vain. Are you struggling to Abbe God in an area of your life that he is challenging you in?

Read 2 Corinthians 6:14-18

10. Why do you think the apostle makes the statement at this point in the chapter?
