Read 9:28-36

1. Given what the disciples have heard in verses 21-26, why are v29 & 25 so significant?
2. Why are Moses and Elijah so significant? How does this relate to v8 & v19?
3. The word translated “departure” in v31 is literally “exodus”. How does this help us understand what the Messiah will face in Jerusalem fitting into God’s plan for Him?
4. What could have been a reason for Peter’s suggestion in v.33? Why do you think the 3 disciples told no one what they saw & heard?

Read Luke 9:37-50

5. Thinking back to 9:1 what is the problem in the story of the man who took his son to the disciples?

6. How does this story help confirm Jesus’ kingship?
7. Why are the disciples so confused by Jesus’ words (v.44-45)?
8. What sort of King do you think people were expecting Jesus to be? What sort of a King did Jesus show he would be?
9. What had the disciples got wrong (v46) & how did Jesus correct them?
10. Why is Jesus’ death and resurrection his crowning moment?
11. What confusion surrounds the identity and mission of Jesus among your family and friends?
